## **Competitions**

Back in January several Denbigh Dragon swimmers competed in the Rotherham Metro A and B grade long course meet, with races taking place over 2 days in the Olympic sized 50-meter pool. This was held at Pond's Forge International Sports Centre, Sheffield. Our youngest swimmer was 10 years old, and eldest 17 years old. A few medals were won, and a lot of personal bests improved.

In February the Swim Wales North Wales Regional gala was held over 3 days in Llandudno. Nine of the Dragons competed in 39 races. Eva Evans got a silver medal for the 17+ female 800M Freestyle event also knocking over 3 seconds off her personal best. She also got a further 6 Top 10 placings.

It was a busy March, with two galas for us. The Menai AA B Meet held at Llandudno on 5<sup>th</sup> March had 7 of the Dragons competing in 21 races.

Numerous medals were won, and personal bests continued to be improved upon.

The Swim Conwy Spring Meet followed on the 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> March in Llandudno's 25M pool. There were 11 swimmers taking part in this, including 4 new competitors who took part in their very first gala — well done to Molly (10), Kate (11), Catrin (15) & Caitlin (10). Elenid Parry (10) came away with 2 medals, Bronze in the 50M Butterfly and Silver in her first attempt at 200M Backstroke. (*Photo of some of the team below*).

One of our own Dragons, Cerys Thomas (14), qualified to swim in the Swim Wales National Championships. This was to be held over the Easter holidays but was cancelled due to issues with the Swansea and Cardiff 50M pools. It has been rescheduled in Liverpool on 20<sup>th</sup> May. Amazing and well done to you Cerys.
